Impact a life for Eternity





Millions in Muslim West Africa, including Togo, have never heard the Gospel or had access to a local church. Reaching these unreached communities requires intentional strategies, sharing the Good News, building meaningful relationships, and establishing sustainable local churches that can grow and multiply. When new churches are planted in unreached areas, the Gospel is shared in culturally relevant ways, disciples are made, long-term local leaders are raised, and outreach strategies are developed leading to additional churches and lasting transformation far beyond spiritual growth. Each new church is built on a strong foundation, equipping it to become self-sufficient. Your gift provides vital resources for evangelism, discipleship, leadership training, and sustainable growth. With every new congregation, communities are transformed by the love of Christ-growing and multiplying to spread faith and hope far beyond their borders.

For \$2,400 per year or \$200 per month, you can equip and support a dedicated church planter serving in a rural community. Funds needed for this project: \$10,000.





In remote villages across Togo, access to healthcare is often unattainable. Mobile Medical Teams step into these underserved areas to provide essential medical consultations. treatments, and medications, reaching people who would otherwise go without care. Beyond physical healing, each encounter creates opportunities for meaningful relationships and lasting spiritual transformation. Since 2010, these committed medical teams have delivered life-changing healthcare to thousands of patients throughout Togo, West Africa. Through this short-term volunteer program, medical professionals from the U.S. collaborate with local doctors, nurses, and churches to serve communities in need. Each team, comprising doctors, nurses, dentists, pastors, and caring volunteers, collaborates with NHMI partner churches and local medical staff to deliver comprehensive care that addresses both physical and spiritual needs. By sharing Christ's love in practical ways, they bring healing, hope, and the Gospel message to those who need it most.

Funds needed for this project: \$10,000.







Many families in Kponou, southeastern Togo, face health issues that are preventable and treatable, but access to healthcare is limited. The few available facilities lack staff, medication, and necessary equipment, and those needing specialized care must travel 150 miles to Lomé, which is difficult for most. To help, New Harvest Missions International (NHMI) and local partners are planning a new healthcare center in Kponou, designed to serve over 16,000 people in nearby villages. This center will provide affordable outpatient, maternity, and preventive services, and promote health education, reducing death from treatable illnesses. It will also be a compassionate place where people can experience Christ's love, encouraging local church growth.

The project will be built in four phases, with \$25,000 needed for the first phase.





In rural Southeast Togo, many families struggle daily to find safe water. With no consistent source of water, women and children often walk long distances, carrying heavy containers, which takes time away from learning, farming, and family care. This situation causes health problems, limits food and education, and traps families in poverty. Our project aims to build a new borehole to provide clean and reliable water for the community and nearby villages. Partnering with local churches and leaders, we are drilling sustainable wells within half a mile of those in need. Access to clean water can also support church growth, discipleship, and community renewal. We plan to build four wells; three are already funded, and we hope you will help us bring the fourth to life.

The funds needed for this project are \$15,000 per well.







In rural Togo, inguinal and umbilical hernias are common but often go untreated due to poverty and limited access to surgery. Many affected are pastors, church members, farmers, and parents in their most productive years, living with chronic pain or at risk of life-threatening complications. The Hernia Surgery Clinic Project provides free, life-restoring surgeries for those who would otherwise go untreated. Partnering with local churches, medical teams, and community leaders. the project brings healing and renewed strength enabling individuals to care for their families, serve their churches, and communities once again. By addressing real health needs with compassion, we build trust and relationships that support new church planting and community transformation. Your support will cover surgical treatments for many patients, including essential supplies, medications, transportation, logistics, postoperative care, and follow-up support.

Total funds needed for this project: \$8,000.







A motorcycle enables a District pastor who is responsible for three to four congregations in remote areas. Gifts to this fund will help a district pastor to serve the distant congregations, and preaching stations, help with leadership Issues, discipleship, outreach, and prayer they need to grow in the grace and knowledge of the Lord Jesus Christ. With \$3,000 you can provide one motorcycle for a district pastor or church planter; we are looking to purchase two Motorcycles. You can help share the cost with your gift too.

Total funds needed for this project: \$6,000.







New Harvest Missions International (NHMI) is making a difference in underserved communities in Togo through education, healthcare, clean water, and spiritual support. Our teams travel to remote villages to construct schools, churches, drill wells, and train local leaders, sharing the Gospel along the way. Many of these areas are only accessible via rough, unpaved roads that become nearly impassable during the rainy season. Without a reliable vehicle, our work is delayed, supplies can't reach those in need, and follow-up is difficult, reducing our impact. We urgently need a Toyota Hilux doublecab to operate safely year-round, improve coordination, and expand our outreach. The total cost is \$35,000, with \$10,000 already raised. Your donation can help us reach more people with hope and support.

Funds needed for this Project: \$25,000.





This project aims to equip NHMI's new Bible and Seminary campus with a state-of-the-art sound and audiovisual system. The installation will include professional-grade PA equipment, microphones, amplifiers, speakers, and video projection systems designed to deliver clear, high-quality sound and visuals across the campus. With these modern tools, worship services, classroom instruction, and leadership training sessions will be significantly enhanced, creating a dynamic and spiritually uplifting environment for students, faculty, and visiting leaders. Additionally, this investment will enable the seminary to host national and international conferences. seminars, and ministry events with excellence. It will also open doors for the campus to generate income through event rentals and conference hosting, strengthening the long-term financial sustainability of NHMI's mission. Your partnership in this initiative will help equip pastors, missionaries, and lay leaders to serve more effectively, advancing the Gospel throughout Francophone Africa and beyond.

Total funds needed for this project: \$14,000.







Bridge of Hope is a program run by New Harvest Missions International (NHMI) that connects caring donors with underprivileged children in rural Togo, West Africa. Many of these children come from families of subsistence farmers who cannot afford school fees or supplies. Your sponsorship provides Christ-centered education that fosters both academic success and spiritual growth. Each gift helps cover tuition, textbooks, uniforms, meals, healthcare, and school supplies. Students also receive personal mentoring, Bible lessons, and prayer support that nurture growth in faith and character development. This project aims to bridge the educational gap between rural and urban students. \$360 sponsors one child for a full year, covering tuition, meals, school supplies, and spiritual support. We currently have 50 children waiting for sponsors. Join us in building a Bridge of Hope, one child, one future at a time. We are looking for 50 sponsors

Funds needed for this project: \$18,000.





Congregations in West Africa often lack a permanent structure for worship services and fellowship, which exposes them to various problems. Their meetings and ministries are also hindered because they don't have space to gather as a church family. The cost of building a chapel in the areas where NHMI is serving is \$14,000.
